AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §122-11 DE PERE MUNICIPAL CODE
BY ADOPTING A QUOTA ON THE ISSUANCE OF
CLASS "A" BEER AND LIQUOR LICENSES

THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DEPERE DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

Section 1. §122-11 of the De Pere Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

1. by deleting the current section heading and inserting the following in its place:

Limitations on Class "A" Licenses

2. and by creating the following subsection:
§122-11(c) *Quotas Established.* The number of Class "A" licenses granted by the Common Council shall not exceed the following:
 1. One Class "A" Beer license per 2,300 population.
 2. One Class "A" Liquor license per 2,300 population.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

As you are aware, my office has been requested to research whether other municipalities have adopted quotas on Class A licenses and if so, what those quotas are. I discovered is that very few Wisconsin municipalities in fact have established quotas on the issuance of Class A licenses.

As you know, the State of Wisconsin has adopted quotas on the number of Class B licenses municipalities may issue. Although the actual formula is rather obtuse, the Class B quota is generally based on the number of licenses issued as of 1975, plus one additional license per 500 population increase thereafter.

Under §125.10 Wis. Stats., municipalities may enact regulations in addition to those found in state liquor law provided they do not conflict with state statutes. Establishing quotas on Class A licenses do not conflict with state statutes. Therefore, municipalities may individually enact quotas on the issuance of Class A licenses within their jurisdiction.

Below is a table showing the municipalities I have found which do have Class A quotas. Under the name of each municipality you will see a number in bold print. That number is the 2003 estimated population for that municipality. De Pere's estimated January 1, 2003 population is 21,529.
