2. Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

4. Public comment upon matters not on the agenda and other announcements.

Aldersperson Nelson announced the partnership between the De Pere Health Department and the Medical College of Wisconsin's NEW Psychiatry residency program, which will provide information sessions on mental health conditions, treatment options and services available. These sessions will be held on the last Wednesday of each month at the Community Center. The sessions aim to lessen the stigma around mental illness, and will focus on a different topic each month. The first session will be held on August 29th at 6:30 PM, and the topic will be anxiety. Aldersperson Nelson noted that all are welcome to attend.

Aldersperson Hansen reminded viewers of the new ordinance which requires that garbage and recycling polycarts be enclosed or screened from public view. He thanked the Public Works Department for sending out a reminder letter in this quarter's water bill.

5. Recommendation from the Board of Park Commissioners to Consider Proposal from Definitely De Pere to Construct and Fundraise for Historical Monument.

Aldersperson Raasch expressed concern with the language on the monument, which describes the mission to christianize Native Americans. He noted that many tribes were negatively impacted by the missionary process; many children, including his own grandmother, were forced to attend missionary schools and were sometimes removed from their families. Aldersperson Raasch reached out to local tribes for feedback and did

hear back from some of them. He understands the historical context but will vote against the recommendation.

Discussion followed regarding wording of the plaque and the presence of other markers from the same era. Other Council members acknowledged the concerns raised.

Aldersperson Crevier noted that he also feels it is an accurate representation of what actually happened and an important part of local history.

Upon roll call vote, the motion passed 6-1 with Aldersperson Jennings abstaining and Aldersperson Raasch voting nay.
