2. Application for a temporary premises description change to a Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage/"Class B" Intoxicating Liquor license held by Union Hotel Corporation.

City Attorney Judy Schmidt-Lehman explained that the application requests a temporary premises expansion to include the sidewalk on the north side of James Street, from the restaurant to the barn. The map provided, however, includes the eastern half of the new Michael J Walsh Plaza which extends beyond the hotel parcel (marked in blue on the map). Judy noted that City ordinance allows for extension only into areas that are immediately adjacent to the premises. The law department is requesting that the action of the Council be limited to that area immediately adjacent to the property.

Aldersperson Carpenter moved, seconded by Aldersperson Kunding to approve the area outlined in red on the map – the western half of the Plaza that borders the parcel.

Discussion followed regarding City ordinance that prohibits alcohol on public ways with the exception of street festivals or similar events. Judy confirmed that it is the responsibility of the license holder to enforce the boundaries of the licensed area.
