The project will include refurbishing the four floating docks and two stationary docks at the Fox Point Boat Launch. The floating docks will have all boards replaced to recycled plastic and replace the floats. The stationary docks will have wood boards replaced to recycled plastic boarding. Our anticipated time line is as follows;

November 2016 - Bids obtained on dock renovation

December 2016 - Floating docks shipped out for renovation

February 2017 - Docks returned from renovation

May 2017 - Replacement of boarding on stationary docks

Section 7: Project Feasibility Statement

Describe, justify and state the project objectives to include economic, environmental and engineering aspects (who, what, where, when and why). Include dimensions of the property and proposed facilities.

The City of De Pere owns and operates the very popular Fox Point Boat Launch, located on the north side of De Pere and on the east side of the Fox River. The boat launch facility is located on close to 6 acres of property along the Fox River, and is well known throughout the state as it serves as a primary launch site during the annual walleye run in the spring of the year. The boat launch has over 100 vehicle/trailer stalls and is typically full or close to full on a daily basis during the spring.

While the City has kept up on maintenance over the years (ie. parking lot maintenance, building repairs, etc...), the boarding for the floating and stationary docks have deteriorated to a point they should be replaced. Boards continue to weather and deteriorate, and are not longer to be suitably replaced. The floating docks are 6'x60' sections, while the stationary docks are 9'x35' and 20'x77'.

The Fox Point Boat Launch is part of a larger river access program the City offers. There are three boat launches and two transient docking facilities the City offers for people to access and enjoy the Fox River. The boat launches charge a fee via a day or season pass fee, however the transient boat docks do not.

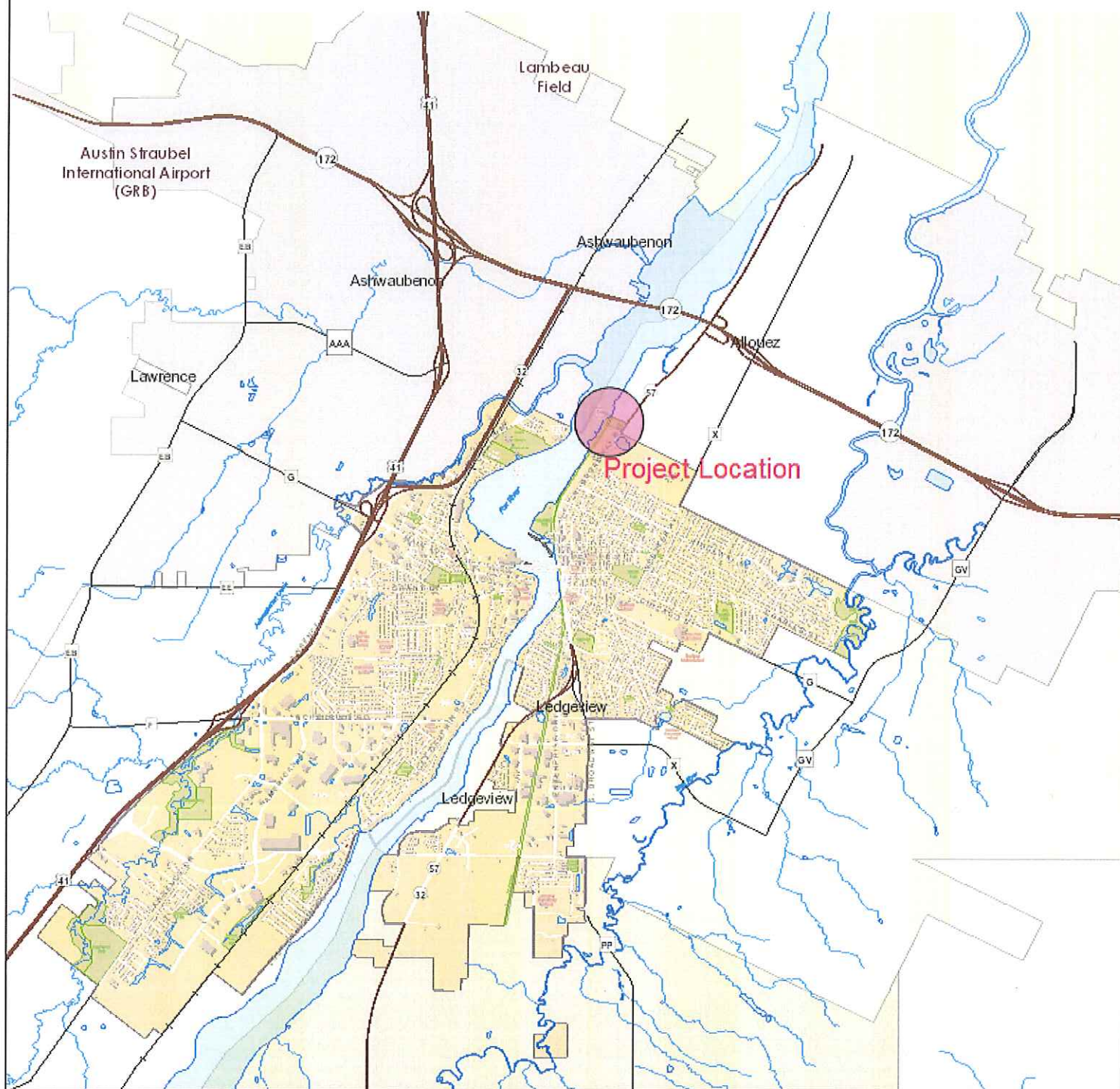

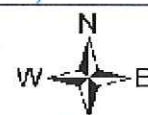

SUBJECT: Consider Optimist Playground Surface Project 16-12.*

Staff advertised for the poured in place playground surfacing at Optimist Park. As been the norm for the past couple years, we only received one bid. The industry does not have many contractors willing to perform the work in the area and state. The bid received was from Bluemel's, which is the company we have worked with on our other playgrounds.

With relation to the overall project budget, we have \$95,000 allocated, and we appear to be in-line.

- Playground Cost	\$41,044
- Poured In Place surfacing	\$34,700
- Rubber Fiber/Matting (Est)	\$ 3,000
- Sidewalk (Est)	\$14,000
- Landscaping (Est)	\$ 2,256
Total	\$95,000

Staff is recommending awarding the contract to Bluemel's in the amount of \$34,700.
