4. Application for a Class "B" Fermented Malt Beverage License and "Class B" Intoxicating Liquor License for ESales, Inc. (DBA VIP Daiquiri Lounge) 308 Main Av. Submitted by ESales, LLC; Agent Tye Hartwell, De Pere, WI.*

For the benefit of new License Committee members, Assistant City Attorney Kristen sent a memo to elected officials earlier in the day outlining what can be considered in approving or denying a new liquor license application. Examples include the number of existing bars in an area, prior police calls for service, etc. She also pointed out that some communities choose to hold licenses for future development; the City currently has six Class B combo licenses available. City Clerk Carey Danen reported that she was contacted by two neighboring business owners who expressed concern about the number of licensed establishments on the 300 block of Main Av. The Police Department reported one call for a noise complaint during the time that the previous license holder was operating VIP Daiquiri. Alderperson Gantz, noting that the applicant is also the license holder for another establishment on the block, asked if Pasquale's has had any reported issues. Staff does not have any record of complaints for that location.
