Alderperson Hansen asked how the process would be managed from an IT standpoint; Larry stated that staff is working on a product that would be accessible on the City server.

City Administrator Delo said this is the method being recommended by The Counties Association and the League of Wisconsin Municipalities. It gives Council a lot more flexibility in how the funds are used, and Council members will still have the ability to specifically designate funds for particular uses. Discussion followed about the restrictions of the program, reporting requirements, and audit procedures. The funds have to be designated by the end of 2024, and spent by 2026. Alderperson Hansen suggested creating a centralized process for staff and elected officials to submit ideas, and then schedule a special study session at some point in the future.

RE: Front Street Development Title Issues

The City-owned Front Street Parking Structure has been identified as a site for redevelopment in the City's downtown. The purpose of this memo is to discuss various title issues the Law Department has identified related to several City-owned properties in order to proceed with development on Front Street.

Condemned Land

A small piece of land located behind 126 S Broadway is owned by the City, shown in pink on the attached map. Brown County land records show this piece of land was condemned and transferred to the City in 1971 from what is now Parcel ED-789, shown in green on the attached map. However, proper documentation showing the transfer of this property to the City has not been located. Staff in the Brown County Listing Department suggested the Lis Pendens filed with the condemnation proceedings was likely accepted as a conveyance deed back in 1971, although a Lis Pendens would not be sufficient documentation now. Parcel ED-789 is currently owned by 126 South Broadway, LLC. In order to clear up this issue, the City is working with 126 South Broadway, LLC toward a mutually acceptable solution. Staff is confident an agreement will be reached and the quit claim deed signed, thereby clearing up any title issues at this location. In the event that does not occur, Council approval to initiate litigation will be required.

Parcel ED-796

Parcel ED-796, depicted in yellow on the attached map, is currently owned by the City. This parcel was conveyed to the City in 1971 and included a restrictive covenant granting parking and access rights for the benefit of Parcel ED-784. Parcel ED-784, depicted in orange on the attached map, is currently owned by MP Broadway LLC. The Law Department has been working with the owners of ED-784 to release this restriction and we are confident the parties will be able to resolve these issues in preparation for development without the need for litigation.

Parcel ED-794

Parcel ED-794, depicted in blue on the attached map, is currently owned by the City. This property was conveyed to the City in 1971 by Harry and Catherine Macco. This transfer included a restrictive covenant, which states in relevant part:

“This deed is given subject to the condition that the grantee (City) construct a public highway, a southerly extension of Front Street, from Charles Street southerly to connect with South Broadway Street at Merrill Street, providing ingress and egress to and from the above described property and adjacent property to be used as a public parking facility by Grantee...”

The Front Street construction requirement is satisfied, but the public parking requirement remains and must be dealt with to ensure clear title. Because the restriction appears to benefit the public rather than one or more specific property owners, additional action is required to remove this restriction. The Law Department is of the belief that an action should be filed in Circuit Court to clear up this issue, naming the previous owners of ED-789 as well as any unknown interested parties as defendants. We will need the approval of Council to initiate this action. Before filing the action, we propose a public hearing be held on the matter to gather public input and attempt to identify potential parties with conflicting interests. It is unknown at this time how long this process will take and will depend upon the timing of the public hearing as well as the Court’s calendar and preferred scheduling process.

Utility Easement

A gas main easement was granted to Wisconsin Public Service in 1991. This easement will need to be vacated/discontinued. The steps to put that in motion will start at the Plan Commission in the near future.

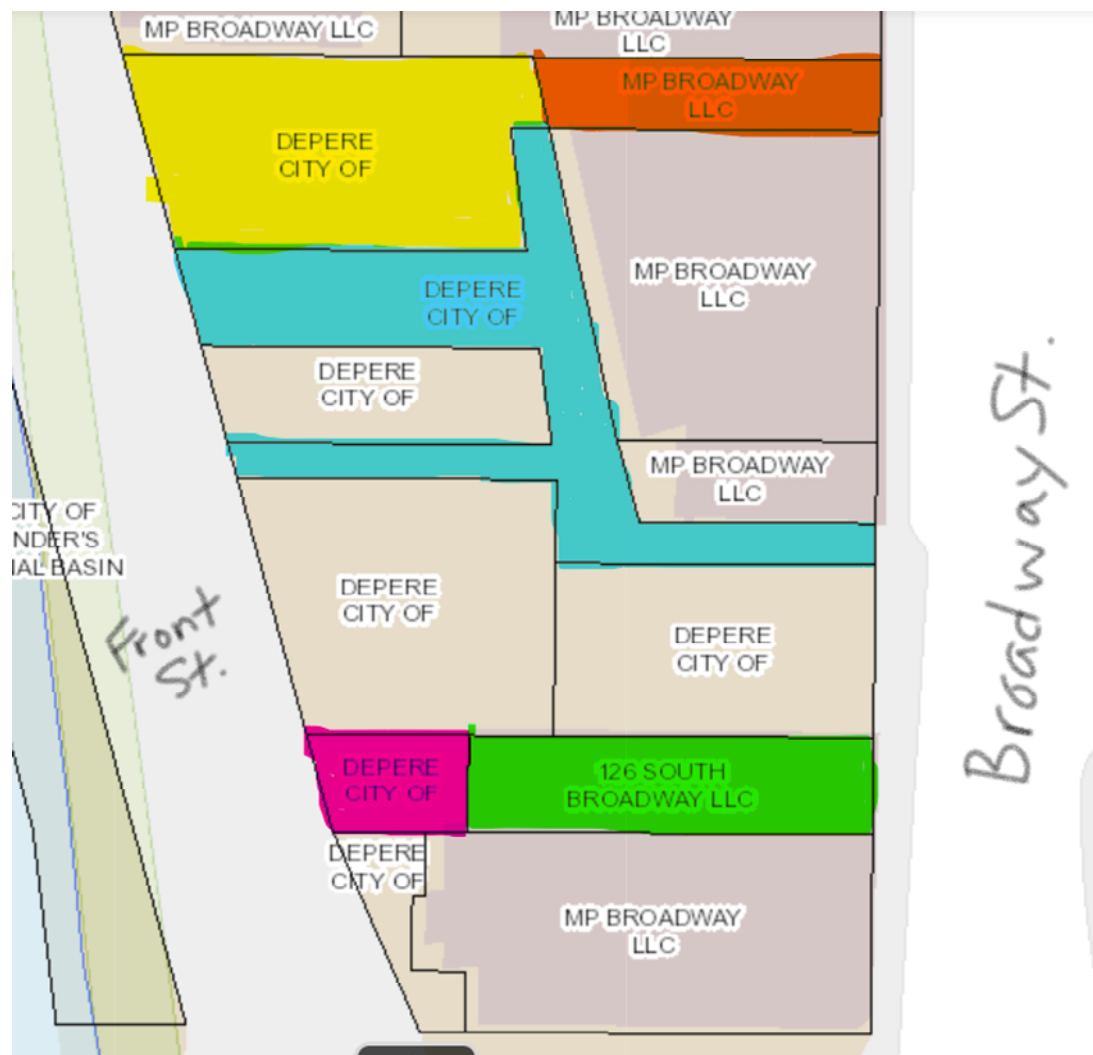
Staff requests/recommendations
