Alderperson Bauer moved, seconded by Alderperson Heuvelmans to approve Operator License Applications #1, 3, 5-7 and to table Operator License Applications #2, 4, and 8. Upon vote, motion carried unanimously.

10. Future agenda items. Alderperson Heuvelmans requested review of the City's lack of a sexual offender ordinance; also to review what the surround municipalities have in place.
11. Fire Department Organizational Study Overview and Direction.
Chief Jeffrey Roemer recommends functional consolidation with GBMFD which includes the areas of Fire Prevention, Fire-EMS Operations, Technical Rescue, Water/Ice Rescue, Training, Purchasing, Staff Functions, and Administrative. Discussion followed regarding the Public Safety Option and why the Chief is not recommending that for the City of De Pere. Discussion followed. The Council agreed to direct Fire Chief Jeffrey Roemer and City Administrator Larry Delo to move forward with discussions with the Green Bay Metro Fire Department. Alderperson Donovan moved, seconded by Alderperson Bauer to refer back to staff. Upon vote, motion carried unanimously. City Administrator Larry Delo stated that they'll try to have more information available to the Council at the February 4th Council Meeting.
12. Adjournment. Alderperson Crevier moved, seconded by Alderperson Rafferty to adjourn the meeting at 8:32 p.m. Upon vote, motion carried unanimously.
